



A high-payout side bet for casino roulette games

### What is the UpperCut™ Roulette bet?

UpperCut™ is a multi-spin community side bet for roulette. It's based on whether the numbers spun on the roulette wheel form a sequence of increasing numbers: the longer the sequence, the greater the payout. Here's how it works:

1. The player makes a wager on the UpperCut™ wager area.
2. The next spin of the wheel determines the *point* number (similar to craps). If a 36 shows, the UpperCut™ wager loses right away – no number is greater than 36.
3. If the next spin is *greater than* the point number, it becomes the *new* point number; if not, the bet is over. The total number of points, up to a dozen, determines the award based on the payable.

As an example, the sequence 5, 8, 10, 22, 19 has four points before the 19, while the same spins in a different order, 5, 10, 8, 22, 19 has only two. For American roulette, 00 is considered greater than 0 and less than 1.
